Clinton "Cotton" Cheek, age 81, of Albertville, Alabama, passed away on June 23, 2025, at Shepherd's Cove Hospice. He was born on February 3, 1944, to the late Arthur David "A.D." Cheek, Sr. and Mary Lariee Morrell Cheek.

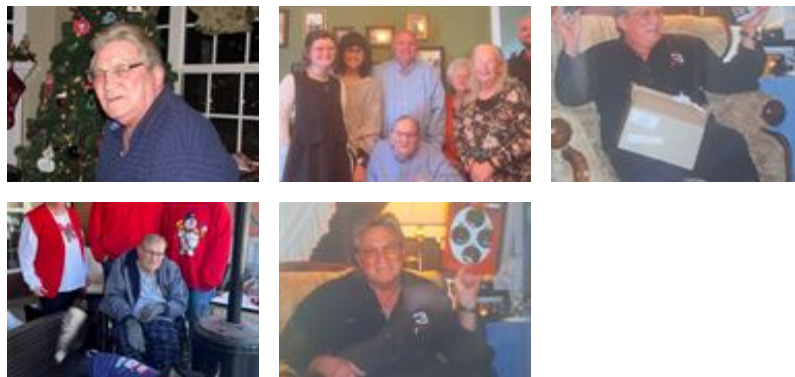
