



Mr. Howell Taylor

November 12, 1934 - November 10, 2015

Phillip Howell Taylor, 80, of Albertville, died Tuesday, November 10, 2015 in Huntsville Hospital.

Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday, November 14, 2015 at Adams Brown Service Funeral Home with Dr. Donald Cotten officiating. Burial will follow in the Friendship Cemetery in the Mt. Hebron Community. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service on Saturday.

Mr. Taylor worked for 30 years at NASA as a procurement officer. He worked on such notable space programs as the Apollo program, the Shuttle program, and Hubble and Chandra space telescope programs. He retired from NASA in 1992 and worked as a contracting consultant, teaching procurement classes around the country for several years.

He was married to Ann Montgomery Taylor for 59 years.

He and Ann were charter members of The Fellowship Church in Albertville.

He earned a bachelor's degree from Jacksonville State University, a master's degree from the University of Oklahoma, and a doctorate of Public Administration from the University of Georgia.

Mr. Taylor was also a retired Lieutenant Colonel in the U.S. Army Reserves.

Along with his wife, Mr. Taylor is survived by his daughters and son-in-law, Carol & Michael Porter and Kay Taylor, and grandchildren, Kate and Sarah Porter. He was preceded in death by his parents, Henry & Jewell Taylor, and brothers, Marlin and James.

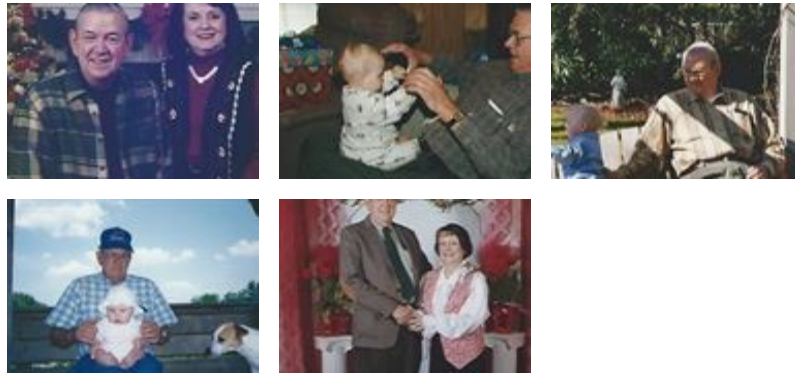
I was very sorry to hear of Phil's death and I want to extend my sympathy to the family.
