“ Dr. Clemmons was our family physician during our time in Albertville. In fact he delivered both me (1961) and my sister (1963) at the old Sand Mountain Infirmary on Broad St. We moved away in 1970 and I remember seeing him only once after that in 1975. In the mid-80's, my granddad, Rev. Raymond Cook, was diagnosed with the shingles by Dr. Clemmons. I was told when Dr. Clemmons lifted Pa Paw's shirt and saw the blisters, he told him "I've seen enough. Bro. Cook, if you have any preaching to do in the next couple of weeks, call them and tell them you're staying home. You're not going anywhere. You've got an old fashioned case of the shingles." We extend our condolences to his family and as Pa Paw said a lot from the pulpit, "It's only rough from here to the cemetery, but when you come out on the other side it's smooth sailing. He has left quite a legacy.
