Kimberly Thurmond Morgan, February 14, 1964 – February 27, 2026, 62 years old.

Kim Morgan, lovingly known to most as Kimmy, Mama Kim, or Mimi, passed away at Marshall Medical Center South on Friday, February 27, 2026, surrounded by loved ones after a weeklong stay in the ICU battling flu and pneumonia complications.

Kim was born on February 14, 1964, in Albertville, Alabama. She was a Valentine baby, and was exactly who you would expect someone born on a holiday focused on love to be: loving, selfless, kind, caring.

Kim was proud of many things in her life, but none more-so than her children Blake, Tyler, & Heather. She often told everyone of Blake's kindness, Tyler's talents, & Heather's tenacity — all traits undoubtedly inherited from Kim herself.
