Michael "Todd" Greer, age 56, a lifelong resident of Albertville, Alabama, passed away on November 29, 2025, at Huntsville Hospital. He was diagnosed with Stage IV lung cancer in August of 2025 and bravely fought his illness for four short months.

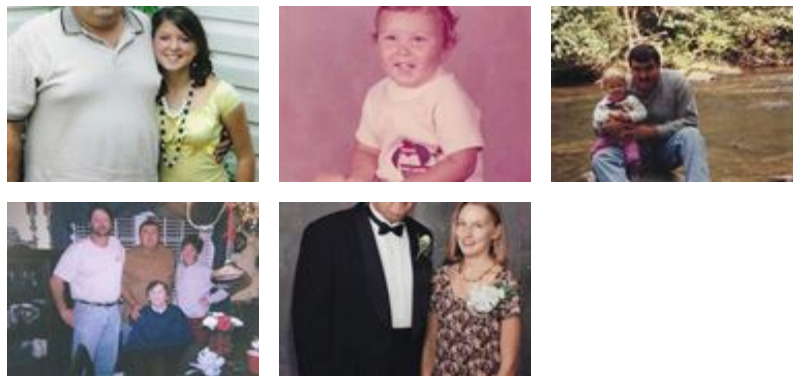
