Mrs. Nancy Jo Hardy, age 85 of Albertville, Alabama passed away Friday, January 9, 2015 at the Halcyon House Hospice in Atlanta, Georgia.

Funeral services will be held at 1pm Tuesday, January 13, 2015 at Christ Episcopal Church of Albertville with Father Ben Alford officiating. The family will receive friends from 12:15pm until the time of service at the Christ Episcopal Church. A private burial will follow at Memory Hill Cemetery.

Mrs. Hardy is survived by her daughter, Nancy Elizabeth Noe. She was preceded in death by her parents, John Asbury "J.A." & Nancy Elizabeth "Nannie" Luther.

Mrs. Hardy was a retired educator, having taught for 40 years. The majority of her tenure was served at Snead State Junior College. She served on the Alabama Women's Commission for 15 years, being appointed by several governors. She also served as Vice President of the Alabama Speech Association and advisory board member for Huntsville Literary Association. Early in her career, she served as a judge of the National Debate Tournament at West Point Military Academy. Mrs. Hardy received numerous awards for her acting excellence while she was a student at Howard College.
