



Robert Claud Grizzard

April 1, 1941 - June 16, 2013

Robert Claud Grizzard, born April 1, 1941, passed away at age 72 on June 16, 2013 at Shepard's Cove Hospice Facility in Albertville after a yearlong battle with lung cancer. Mr. Grizzard resided in Alder Springs, but grew up in Guntersville. He graduated from Marshall County High School in 1962 and served a short time in the National Guard. His first job was working with the Advertiser Gleam. Around age 16, Mr. Grizzard began working for A&P grocery store and continued to work for area grocery stores including Kroger, Piggly Wiggly, and Johnson's Giant Foods. He loved the grocery business and took pride in it. It became like a second home and he continued working until 2010. He enjoyed gardening and was featured in the Advertiser Gleam and WAAY 31 News in 1986 for his record setting tomato plants and pea vines. He also enjoyed Native American culture, artifacts, history, thrifting, and spending time with his wife and family.
