Those fingers of his told many stories, most of all when it was time to go... when those tapping little fingers started, anyone that knew Sam knew by that point he had been in one place too long.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Margaret Ann Strickland and Samuel Henderson Strickland Jr.; sister, Betty Elizabeth Strickland; son, Samuel David Strickland; and brother-in-law, Ronnie Hill.

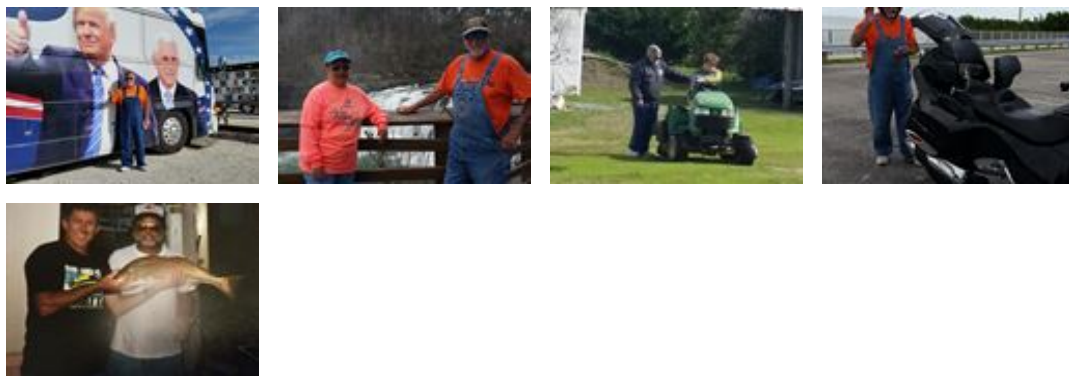
