Sandi Lacy Morris, 38, of Alpharetta, GA died Monday, January 5, 2015 at her home in Alpharetta, following a four and one-half year battle with brain cancer. A memorial service will be Saturday, January 10, 2015 at Adams Brown Service Funeral Home. The family will receive friends from 10-12pm with service following at 12pm. The service will be officiated by Bro. Ed Hamlett.

Sandi was a native of Albertville and a member of First Presbyterian Church. She was active in dance, starting at the age of 4. While attending Albertville High School, she was dance captain of CenterStage show choir and as a band member, she was dance captain of Southern Stars dance line. She attended Wallace State Jr. College on a dance scholarship. She was a 1998 graduate of the University of Alabama. After working for Lexmark and GE Medical Systems, she returned to college and earned a graduate degree from Liberty University in Christian Counseling. At the time of her cancer diagnosis, she was working for Northside Psychological Services in Alpharetta as a counselor to troubled teenagers.

In 2005, Sandi traveled to Bosnia with her church. Their mission was to reach out to the youth in and around a church they supported in order to reach more families, and introduce them to the Christian faith.

She and her husband of eight years, James Morris were active members of

Dunwoody Baptist Church in Georgia.

She is survived by her husband, James Morris; mother, Rosemary Lacy; sister, Sonya (Jim) Matthey; mother-in-law & father-in-law, Karen & Chris Morris; sister-in-law, Maryalice (Alan) Harris; aunt, Judith Spencer; uncle, Bill Spencer; nephews, Austin Matthey, Colton Matthey; niece, Abby Harris; and godmother, Sandy Barkley. She was preceded in death by her father, Jimmy Lacy; grandparents, Elver & Louise Lacy, Evie Lacy, Burk & Ruby Spencer; and uncle, Edwin Lacy.
